DeAnna Kennard regularly brings medical and health education teams to Kersa Illala to treat as many medical problems as possible and reinforce prior teaching and training. As long as the women and children draw water from the river the medical needs will continue to increase.



Participants bring medical experience and supplies, HIV education information, solar showers, soap and shampoo, and hygiene kits to alleviate the suffering and to care for the people.

WHEN WILL WOMEN AND CHILDREN DRAW WATER FROM WELLS?

The most important and exciting achievement will come when we have provided clean water to each person in the village. Clean water access will make the greatest change in life for these people. Until clean water becomes available the people will continue to suffer the hazards of putrid water

hand-hauled by women and children four times a day from a distance of one to two miles. Soon the people will not have to share the river water with the animals and parasites, as they bathe and wash laundry."
